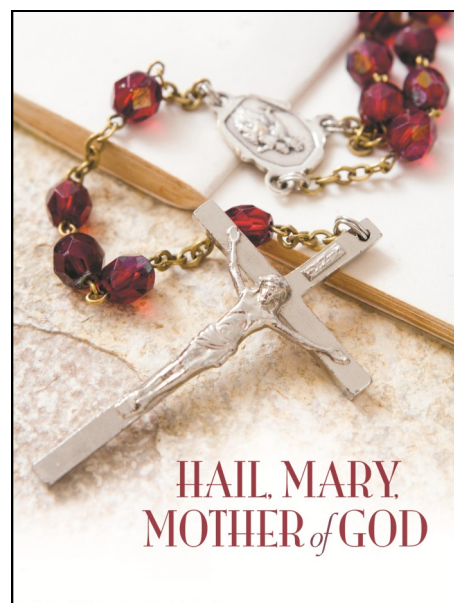

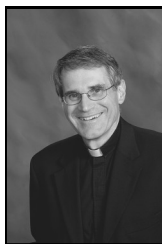

Thank you to everyone involved with the All Saints Music Festival. While I am writing this before event actually takes place, I am aware of the people who have worked on this new concept for over two years, and many more who have helped tremendously in the past months. We hope to have some "close" numbers on how it went financially next weekend. We will review the event in detail, seeing what went well and what we would change; ways to economize or improve. Thanks for your patience with all the announcements during this long time.



Twenty 10th graders from our area were confirmed at a beautiful ceremony at the Cathedral on Tuesday night. Bishop Piche was the presider and gave an engaging homily about opening oneself to having their heart changed, and trusting Jesus to do that potentially scary thing to us.

On the weekend of May 31/June 1 we will have our summer missionary speaker, Fr. Jason Marco from the Diocese of San Carlos, Negros in the Philippines. This is a mission place where half of its land area is mountainous. A vast majority of the people are Catholics (90%), poor, unreached and unserved, relying its subsistence on farming and fishing. Poverty is a harsh reality many endure.

Evangelization, Education, and Livelihood projects through skills development and training are major challenges of the diocese. Fr. Marco will be appealing to raise funds for the following:

Mission Schools – these are schools established in the far-flung and mountainous areas of the diocese catering to children of indigenous people and farmers who have no access to basic education. Funds raised through mission appeals go to the maintenance, sustenance and improvement of schools, facilities and personnel as well as scholarships for some students.

Seminary Construction and Maintenance – Part of the funds also go to the construction and maintenance of the Seminary, source of workers for the Lord's vineyard who will be at the forefront of the diocese's efforts to serve, evangelize and educate the people of God in the Diocese.

Evangelization through School and Community Catechesis, and Social Programs like feeding, skills and livelihood training, community-based health program, disaster risk reduction and management, good governance, care for environment, and the like.

Your most generous response will surely contribute to our goal of building the kingdom of God here on earth.

**Looking forward:** Our next Baptism class is on Saturday, June 14th at 10:30 at St. Mary's Church basement in New Trier. If you are planning a baptism but have not been to a class in three years, please plan on attending.

**Reminder:** On the weekend of June 7/8 we will start our new Sunday schedule, through Labor Day. Saturday, 5:00 pm at St. John the Baptist in Vermillion; Sunday, 8:00 am at St. Mary in New Trier, and 10:00 am at St. Mathias in Hampton. If you have concerns about this schedule or how it changes after Labor Day, please call or write to me, leaving a name or signing the letter. Please remember the effort is to help all three parishes build community in a Mass setting while realizing there will be only one priest serving the three parishes. The Saturday evening Mass will rotate largely because it is so difficult to get people to stay and build community after that Mass. We seem to have more success at that during morning Masses. Without community, we struggle in fulfilling any mission, and without either, there really is no point in calling ourselves a church.

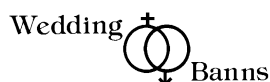

**Q** Which is more important—having a strong faith in God, or obeying God's law?

**A** At first glance, faith and law might seem to be opposites. People's immediate impression might be that faith is personal and flexible, while law is impersonal and rigid. But the two are more closely related than not. Which is better: to be a good citizen or to obey the law of the land? In fact, to be a good citizen means we obey the law. So it is here. To have a strong faith in God means that I trust him, believe in him, and hope in him. Obeying his law is a sign of that belief and the only real way I can express my faith.

Remember the parable of the two sons, both of whom the father asked to go into the vineyard? One said yes, but never went; the other said no, but later regretted it and went anyway. Jesus asks which of the sons had done the will of the father. Our acts must be in accord with God's will, or God's law. What is unique, however, is that in times of difficulty or uncertainty and doubt, a strong faith can help us follow difficult laws, while obeying God's law helps build our faith.

## FASTER BENEFIT DECISIONS FOR VETERANS

On Memorial Day, as we pay tribute to the men and women who gave the ultimate sacrifice for our country, we also share some news about Social Security disability benefits for veterans with disabilities: a new expedited disability process.

We believe it is important to recognize those who currently serve in the military as well as those injured in the line of duty and consider it an honor and a duty to serve them. Whether the injury is physical or mental, getting a decision about Social Security disability benefits from your government shouldn't add to the problems faced by the injured.

Carolyn W. Colvin, Acting Commissioner of Social Security, recently unveiled a new initiative to expedite disability applications from veterans with a Department of Veterans Affairs (VA) disability compensation rating of 100 percent Permanent and Total (P&T). Under the new process, Social Security will treat these veterans' applications as high priority and issue expedited decisions, similar to the way we currently handle disability claims from wounded warriors.

"Our veterans have sacrificed so much for our country and it is only right that we ensure they have timely access to the disability benefits they may be eligible for and deserve," said Acting Commissioner Colvin.

In our draft of minutes for our last parish council meeting, it led the reader to think we were planning on tearing down the school very soon. This is not the case. There is a feeling that it would cost more to remodel it than it would be worth, so some day it will probably go, but first we need to estimate what remodeling would cost, consider constructing a different building, how Faith Formation and storage would be accommodated, and so on. We are at the beginning of forming an investigatory committee to look into such questions. I would expect that any potential demolition would be several years off.

In 1951 the KCs voted to fund the microfilming of irreplaceable documents from the Vatican Library, some dating to the pre-Christian era. The library at St. Louis University is named as the repository for the microfilm. By the 1956 opening of the Knights of Columbus Vatican Film Library at St. Louis University, 9.5 million manuscript pages had been microfilmed and made available for scholars.
